

AVIATION QUESTION OF THE MONTH

Answer to last month's question: *A pilot wants to file a flight plan for a flight in his homebuilt experimental aircraft. What type designator does he use?*

According to AOPA: The FAA's Air Traffic Controller's Handbook (7110.65N) outlines the various aircraft make/model designators. Appendix C lists designators for experimental or homebuilt aircraft as HXA, HXB, or HXC, for aircraft with a cruise speed of 100 knots or less, 100 through 200 knots, or more than 200 knots, respectively.

Is it possible to fly an adequately equipped experimental gyroplane using an instrument rating in another category/class?
